We had first thought of coming to England this summer and then on to India but after further consideration it seems better to go to India via New Zealand and Australia, spending four months or so in these countries. So we shall be leaving here in October. We shall be coming to Europe in the summer of 1947 if all goes well, so I hope we shall meet then.
